## District Collector of Sangli praises Jain Irrigation for accomplishing Miraj Railway Pipeline (MRP) on war footing

District Collector of Sangli, Shekhar Gaikwad praised Jain Irrigation's timely accomplishment of 3 km. pipeline for providing drinking water to the people of Latur by Railway's Water wagons. He wrote a letter to Ashok Jain, Chairman, Jain Irrigation Systems Ltd. (JISL), Jalgaon to express his admiration for Jain's urgent and timely execution and contribution in the MRP project. JISL provided custom made plastic pipes according to the requirement for the Miraj Railway Project, despite Company's extremely hectic and tight work-schedule due to tremendous demand for various kinds of pipes and micro irrigation solutions from the farmers, especially in the peak of summer kharif season preparation.

Miraj District Government administration and Indian Railways created a new glorious chapter in efficient and fast government work by working on war footing to supply drinking water to quench thirst of drought distressed people of Latur. The most challenging part of this was the pipeline up to the railway yard at Miraj. It was extremely crucial to finish laying a new pipeline in such a short time because of the limitations of the Railway infrastructure. Urgent accomplishment of this MRP project depended entirely on this pipeline. Jain Irrigation, keeping their social responsibility ahead of everything else, provided all their technological expertise and expert workforce for this project promptly. This timely co-operation helped finish this task in record 9 days, which normally would have taken a few months otherwise. There were 6 railway crossings and 2 road crossings in this project. Railways sent 2 special water trains each one with 50 wagons from Kota, Rajasthan. Moreover, an exclusive railway yard with new rail tract had to be set up. Thereafter, a pipeline with outlets at specific distances was needed to be constructed. The District Government of Sangli had requested Jain Irrigation to take up the MRP Project. District Collector of Sangli Shekhar Gaikwad thanked and praised JISL Chairman Ashok Jain through a letter for fulfilling this special responsibility.
